



CAI NV Chapter CA Day Rules, Regulations and Conditions

Trade Show & Educational Seminars - October 19, 2012 at the Gold Coast Casino

Contract for Exhibit Space: By submitting an application for Exhibitor Space and acceptance of application, the application becomes a binding contract between Exhibitor's Company, hereafter referred to as "Exhibitor", and the Nevada Chapter of the Community Associations Institute, hereafter referred to as "Chapter".

Hold Harmless: Exhibitor agrees to hold harmless the Chapter, its Board of Directors, its Trade Show Committee Members, its Sponsors or Co-Sponsors, Agents of Participation, its Employees and its Licensees from any and all liabilities that may arise or be asserted as a result of submission or acceptance of an application. Exhibitor understands that the Chapter offers no insurance and insurance must be obtained by and at the expense of the Exhibitor.

Acceptance of Application: Acceptance of the application by the Chapter does not in any way mean an endorsement of the Exhibitor's service or product. Rejection of an application by the Chapter does not in any way imply lack of merit of the Exhibitor's service or product.

Use of Space: No Exhibitor may sublet, assign, or apportion any portion of the space assigned to them. No Exhibitor may exceed its assigned space dimensions in any manner. No Exhibitor may advertise or distribute outside of the space dimensions assigned to them, unless designated as an Exposition Sponsor. This includes interfering with traffic in the Exhibit Hall. No Exhibitor is allowed to advertise, in any manner, for any company – whether associated with or not – other than the Company/Exhibitor that has signed up for, and leased the space.

NO SUITCASING ALLOWED! IF YOU HAVE NOT PURCHASED A BOOTH ~ YOU MAY NOT HAND OUT ANY MATERIALS RELATING TO YOUR COMPANY! YOU WILL BE ISSUED A \$1,350 PENALTY AND ASKED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES!

Restrictions: The Chapter reserves the right to restrict and/or have removed any exhibit which violates the following: Excessive noise, live music, food, beverages, alcohol / food being served, objectionable method of operation, lewd or vested in unacceptable conduct or other reasons that the Chapter may deem to violate the terms of these Regulations and Conditions. In the event of such a removal or restriction of the exhibit – the Exhibitor may be instructed to discontinue the set up, or may be asked to leave the Exhibit Hall. The Chapter will NOT issue any refund of rental, expenses or other damages under these conditions.

Samples and Souvenirs: The Chapter may remove or withdraw permission to advertise or distribute any material it considers objectionable. Games of chance involving the exchange of money are NOT allowed.

Care of Premises: No part of an exhibit nor any sign, nor other materials may be taped, pasted, nailed or otherwise affixed to any wall or ceiling within the exhibit hall. The cost for any repairs due to Exhibitor's negligence or violation of this section will be the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

Fire Regulations: Booth decorations and exhibit construction furnished by Exhibitor must conform to any and all fire regulations. Combustible or other flammable materials may not be used. All materials used by Exhibitor must be flame proof.

Participant Restrictions: Exhibitors and their family members, their employees and their family members, as well as Board Members of the Nevada Chapter and their families, and Trade Show Committee Members are NOT eligible for drawings/prizes held at the individual Exhibitor booths, nor for the Door or Grand Prizes. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE! Exhibitors that wish to provide a prize at their booth, must provide their own methods of "drawing" a winner, and the winner must NOT be any of the above listed individuals stated in these restrictions. Winners will be announced by the committee AFTER 3 PM on the day of the event!

Refunds: Exhibitor understands that refunds will be honored under the following circumstances *without exception*: A 50% refund of fees will be paid if cancellation is received in writing at the Chapter office no later than September 15, 2010. No refunds will be given for cancellation after this date.

Interpretation and Enforcement: These regulations and conditions become a part of the contract between Exhibitor and Chapter. All matters in question not covered by these Regulations and Conditions are subject to the decision of the Chapter and all decisions made shall be so binding on all parties affected by them, as in the case of these original Regulations and Conditions. Authority to enforce these Regulations and Conditions during the Expo shall be the Chairperson and Co-Chairperson of the Exposition, the Chapter Board of Directors, and the Chapter Executive Director.

Attest: By signing and submitting the application, the signor agrees to the terms of these Regulations and Conditions and attests that they are a fully Authorized Representative of the Exhibitor will full authority to sign on behalf of the Exhibitor's Company. The Chapter shall not be liable for failure to perform its obligations under this contract due to acts of God, Nature, or any caused beyond its control. Verbal changes & or cancellations will NOT be accepted.
